PRESENTATION

Technical and biomedical advances have resulted in rapid growth in the need for human tissue allografts, and as a result, there is a need for effective programs of tissue donation, tissue donor screening, tissue recovery and tissue processing around the world. This is an advanced technical and scientific training program which will help participants achieve a high level of knowledge in tissue banking development at the world-wide level and will provide them with skills to lead a tissue bank to a standard of international excellence. There will be an emphasis on public relations activities to increase willingness to donate, obtaining consent, donor evaluation and testing, tissue processing and distribution.

OBJECTIVES

- To enable participants to update their core competences in the newest tissue banking practices.
 - To provide the opportunity to build skills and confidence in developing public support for tissue donation after death.
 - To ensure safe donations by evaluating donor medical and social histories, infectious disease testing, physical examinations and autopsies, if performed.
 - To increase awareness of the clinical use and risks of tissue allografts.
 - To understand international regulatory requirements and how to comply with them.
 - To share professional experiences and encourage the creation of international networks for information sharing in tissue banking.
